Pursuit Goes West to Transpacific

Pursuit is on the truck again. This time she is heading to California for the Centennial Transpacific Yacht Race from Los Angeles to Honolulu. With six eager crew (including Dan Trammell, Jim Whited and Norm Dawley from SMSA), armed with the latest technology, seven spinnakers, seven jibs and three staysails (the main also) she is off to challenge 75 other entrants in this 2225 nm classic. The plan includes a California cruise to Santa Cruz Island, Catalina Island, Santa Barbara, Ventura and Long Beach. Before setting out for the return from Hawaii, we plan to visit Kaneohe Bay and Waimea Bay on Oahu and Nawiliwili and Hanalei on Kauai. By the time *Pursuit* returns after Labor Day, she will have raced 2500 nautical miles, cruised over 3000 nautical miles and been on a truck for 5000 land miles. Technology, radio propagation and batteries willing, we also hope to post a brief synopsis of each day's events at sea via single sideband radio modem to www.norms-site.com.

Day One. We got off to a cool start with a north wind at our backs, and we headed for an anchorage off Walnut Point on the Coan River. Happy hour was kindly hosted by *Nimue*.

Day Two. A day for motoring. A mid-afternoon arrival in Reedville, and an opportunity to walk around the town with its marine museum and attractive restored old houses and, most notable, the absence of Reedville's famous menhaden processing byproduct - the smell! The highlight of our rendezvous was welcoming *Calypso* - Frank and Rita Gerred, who were returning to Solomons after being in the Bahamas all winter. We ferried by dinghy to dinner at "Tommys" and had great food and company.

Day Three. Bidding *Calypso* fair winds as she headed for the barn, the group motorsailed in near windless conditions to the Rappahannock River. The menhaden fleet lead/followed/crisscrossed our convoy as we made our way to Yankee Point on the Corrotoman River. a sheltered spot, commandeering table and chairs for our happy hour reward for a tough day on the Bay!

Day Four. *Mongoose Magic* left us early, headed for home port (but had to pull in for shelter in ...and only managed to get home after the weather system had passed). *Swan* intended to head for Urbanna for a day, but conditions saw them duck into Carter Creek. Day 6. Great sail across the Bay, finally! Our destination - Onancock, and the town dock. This town has lots of pretty stores and plenty of choices for eating out. The dock area has a small park like setting and we gathered under the trees and enjoyed our get-together which included a couple of visiting Germans who were touring the Chesapeake area, so our little group became international.

Day 7. Full day in Onancock. Street strolling, antique and gift shops, and last but not least - *THE HARDWARE STORE* - every man's idea of a place to linger store, plus fresh strawberries, melons and asparagus for the galley. At this last rendezvous our singlehander, Fred, on *Kalypso*, who had every night produced hors d'oeuvres of incredible variety (kumquats anyone?), appeared in full chef regalia bearing hot crab balls and wasabi, and more gourmet delights.

Day 8. *Kalypso* departed very early to head south for Cape Charles to continue Fred's research into the Chesapeake voyages of Capt. John Smith. He plans to visit each documented site and hopefully

will publish his findings. Our dwindling fleet headed for Mill Creek on the Great Wicomico for our last night of the cruise. We raised sails and had a good trip across. *Nimue* joined the group again, for an overnigher. Thanks to *Swan* for hosting our rendezvous here, and to Kermitt for his entertaining reminiscences from his long and active life. Does anyone remember the "Agony Hounds", a band he played in as a young man in Wales, ND ??
